

# DIRECTIONS TO NLC INSURANCE COMPANIES

## From Bradley Airport:

Follow signs to the Route 20 connector (East). Follow Route 20 (East) to Route 91 (South) towards Hartford. In Hartford, take Exit 30 (a left exit) onto Route 2 (East). Continue with the directions **From Hartford** below.

## From Hartford:

Take Route 2 (East) to Exit 28S (Route 395 South). Follow Route 395 South to Exit 80. At the light at the end of the ramp, turn left onto Route 82 (East). Continue with the directions **From Route 82** below.

## From New London:

Take Route 32 (North) to Route 395 (North) to Exit 80E. Turn right at the end of the ramp and continue with the directions **From Route 82** below.

## From Boston:

Take Route I-95 (South) to Route 295 (South). (Route 295 begins just north of Providence RI.) Follow Route 295 (South) to the exit for Route 6 (West). Take Route 6 (West) to Route 395 (South). Follow Route 395 (South) to exit 80 and turn left at the light at the end of the ramp. Continue with the directions **From Route 82** below.

## From NYC :

Take Route 95 (North) to Route 395 (North). (Route 395 is a few miles east of the Connecticut River.) Follow Route 395 to exit 80E and take a right at the end of the ramp. Continue with the directions **From Route 82** below .

## From Route 82 and Route 395 intersection:

Follow Route 82 (East) which is also called West Main Street. Go through 11 traffic lights. At the 12<sup>th</sup> light, turn right onto North High Street. It is about 1.9 miles from Route 395 to the light. *(There is a Wonderbread Outlet and a Midas Muffler shop on the right and a large, new Fire Station on your left where you will turn)* At the stop sign (which is just a few car lengths down), take a left onto High Street. Follow High Street around the corner, past the large white building on the left (American Ambulance). NLC's entrance is on the right. Follow the drive in either direction to the front of the building (the side facing away from the river ) and park in the visitors' parking area.
